

Cancer Core Europe Summer School in Translational Cancer Research Portugal, Albufeira, October 7-11, 2019

Under the umbrella of Cancer Core Europe (CCE) and organized in cooperation with the German Cancer Consortium (DKTK), the German Cancer Research Center (DKFZ), and the National Center for Tumor Diseases (NCT) Heidelberg, the 2019 International Summer School in Translational Cancer Research will bring together scientists and clinicians from the entire cancer research continuum.

Today, education with a focus on translational cancer research is still an unmet need. Therefore, the Summer School will give examples of research areas covering the cancer research continuum from basic, through clinical research, to what is needed for an adoption into the health care system and outcomes research. Well-esteemed lecturers will give overview presentations and be available for discussions. An important goal of the Summer School is the interaction between participants coming from both preclinical laboratories and clinical centers. We aim at stimulating interactions for multidisciplinary collaborations at an international level.
